The Fall 2022 group of CAMCA Fellows from Central Asia, Mongolia, the Caucasus and Afghanistan completed a six-week program of high-level meetings and research from October 4th-November 11th. 2022.

The Fellows had an intensive schedule of group meetings in Washington, D.C. with representatives of the U.S. government, business community, media, think tanks, academia and NGOs, as well as attended conferences at top institutions to better understand opinion-making and policy-making in the U.S. Fellows also traveled to Detroit, Michigan and Chicago, Illinois for meetings with local government officials, businesses and organizations, gaining insights on American democracy beyond the nation's capital.

In the final week of their program Fellows collaborated to present on the topic of "CAMCA: A New Era" at a Central Asia-Caucasus Institute Forum for local professionals interested in the region.
